**The first meeting for 2023 will be different to our
usual format.**

Instead of a guest speaker, we will have two sales tables, plus hear from some of our members who will talk about their expertise in several art-related topics. There will be continuous supper, NO show and tell, and a chance to catch up with fellow artists.

The two sales tables:

There will be two sales tables. One table will be for arty items you no longer require and are happy to donate to the Art Group for sale. For example, used canvases, unwanted but useable tubes of paint, brushes, magazines - really just any stuff you no longer require. Art Group will put a modest price on them, sell them (CASH only), and proceeds go to the Art Group. This is an excellent opportunity if you have had a summer tidy-up and find you no longer need everything you thought you needed.

The second sales table will be space for items likely to be of greater value, such as easels, larger canvasses, specialist items or books of value. Bring them along (or a photo of them), and see if there are any takers. Such sales will be on a private sale basis and all transactions will be your own responsibility. It is a chance for you to sell higher value, but no longer needed art items, and recover some of your costs.

Who does what?

Once the sales table activity has quietened down, we will introduce three or four (or five if there is time) of our members who have expertise in a particular area, for example, working with inks or resins, mediums and varnishes, or mixed media/collage. Our membership has grown in the past two years and we want to make the expertise within our group known to as many members as possible.

Also, if anyone has any art related questions, there will be Question Time at the end and hopefully we will find a person to help address your queries.

The meeting aims to close around 9pm.




